## 1 Formalities

### 1.1 Summary

These instructions govern what applies to LinTek's inter-groups.

### 1.2 Purpose

The purpose of these instructions is to assist the student union management in its work with inter-groups and to clarify what expectations the Union Board has of LinTek's inter-groups.

### 1.3 Scope

These instructions apply to everyone in the union management who, in accordance with the job description, is responsible for a cross-group.

## 2 General provisions

The chair of each cross-group is appointed by the Union Board and is proposed to be a member of the union management. Members of each cross-group are appointed by the chair of the cross-group, who also decides how the cross-group will be organised. There may be more groups if necessary.

## 3 Groups

### 3.1 Commercial Group

The purpose of the Commercial Group is to bring together committed students whose activities are directed towards the business community. This is to ensure consistent communication from LinTek regardless of project or contact point.

### 3.2 Marketing Group

The purpose of the Marketing Group is to provide committed students working for LinTek in the marketing area with a group in which it is possible to work creatively within LinTek's graphic identity to generate a uniform image of LinTek's graphic communication.

### 3.3 IT Group

The purpose of the IT Group is to bring together LinTek's IT positions in one group to promote LinTek's IT activities.
